Important notes:

 Do NOT use pipe tape or sealant on any "swivel" fitting (anything with a rubber cone seal or flat washer in it)
Do NOT over tighten any of the fittings with rubber seals. Snug plus a little more is all that's needed to seal. Over torquing fittings can damage the seals

3) Hoses are all labeled and match the labels next to hoses on the diagram

Testing

1) Turn the selector valve to "use tank"

2) Turn the water pump on.

3) Bleed air from each fixture by turning hot/cold on at sink, shower, rear shower, and flushing toilet until there's no air coming out

4) Leave pump on for 20 minutes and listen for the pump to cycle while visually checking for leaks. If the pump cycles, you may have a leak.
